Historically Colorado Springs has shown little regard for the quality of water flow down the Fountain River. By requiring Colorado Springs to take its water below the Fountain River/Arkansas River confluence is the only way Colorado Springs will ever make a reliable commitment to the quality of water that flows below the confluence.
