Comments: It appears that a substantial savings in total cost would occur if Alt. C would be put into use. The cost of <sup>the</sup> R.O.W. <sup>acquiring</sup> would be lower if located away from the urban growth corridor. Maintenance would also be lower. A definitive benefit would be that the Fountain <sup>R.</sup> would get cleaned up. The cost would be (at least) lower than 2, 3 or 5 - the R.O.W. of these 3 would have greater impact on the development of along the R.O.W. route. There would be less impingement of urbanization along Rte 6. The offshoot of C would be the clean up of the Fountain. It would be a great benefit to the municipalities down stream along the Ark.
